

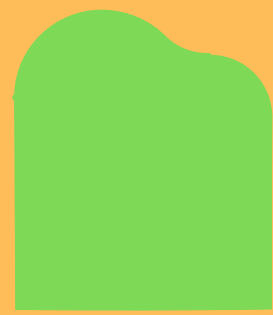

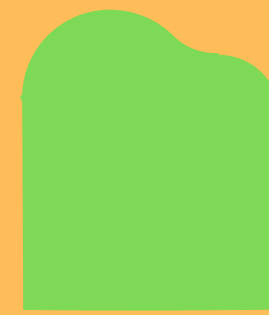
Biased

A republican is a political party represented by an donkey (more info on slide 12)

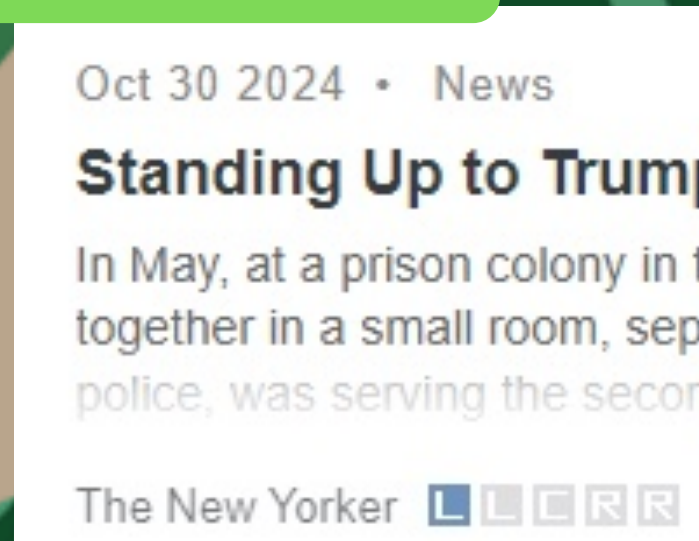


Biased Media is

Any where you look there will be some amount of biased. even the news is biased

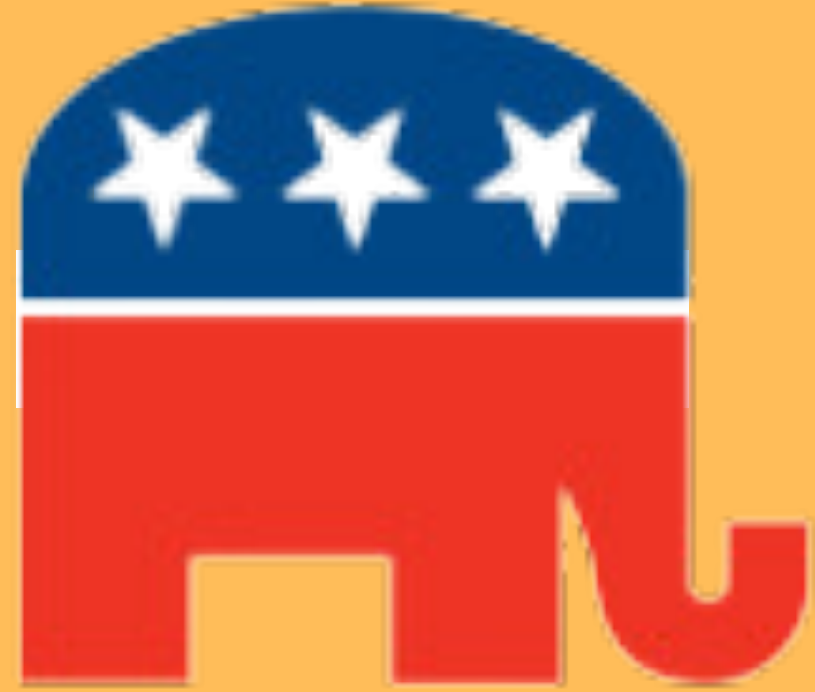


You think you will read The New Yorker about trump oh their for sure biased

democratic ideologys

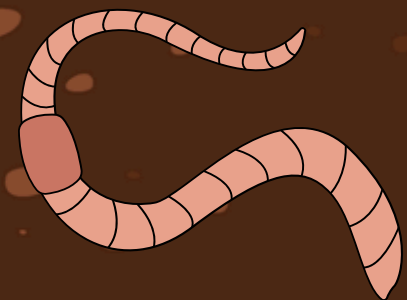
